Matt Ackers-Johnson is an Assistant Professor and Principle Investigator at the National University of Singapore Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine Cardiovascular and Metabolic Translational Research Program. He conducted his Ph.D. at the University of Cambridge in the field of vascular inflammation, and now specialises in primary cardiovascular cell isolation, single cell transcriptomics, and derivation of resident and immune cardiac-relevant cell types from human pluripotent stem cells for 2D and 3D organoid cell-cell interaction and disease modelling.
