

Takeshi Suetomi MD. PhD. is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Medicine and Clinical Science at Yamaguchi University Graduate School of Medicine, Japan. He received his MD in 2004 and completed his PhD in Medicine in 2012 based on his work elucidating the molecular mechanisms of catecholaminergic polymorphic ventricular tachycardia (Suetomi et al. *Circulation*, 2011). He completed a postdoctoral fellowship at the University of California, San Diego. His research is focused on the relationship of the Calcium/calmodulin-dependent protein kinase II (CaMKII), innate inflammation and tissue remodeling (Suetomi et al. *Circulation*, 2018). Dr. Suetomi is a board-certified cardiologist with expertise in heart failure, pulmonary hypertension, and cardiovascular interventions. He is also a board-certified interventionalist for balloon pulmonary angioplasty (BPA), recognized by the Japanese Circulation Society. His research has been supported by national and international grants, including from the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science and the American Heart Association.
