

Dr. Yibin Wang is currently the Tanoto Foundation Professor in Diabetes and Director of Signature Research Program in Cardiovascular and Metabolic Diseases at DukeNUS Medical School, Singapore, Senior PI at National Heart Center of Singapore, Professor of Medicine at Duke University School of Medicine, Durham USA. Dr. Wang's research mainly focuses on genetic basis and molecular mechanisms of heart failure and metabolic disorders, with more than 280 peer-reviewed publications. He currently serves as an Associate Editor for *Cardiovascular Research*, *Journal of Molecular and Cellular Cardiology*, *JACC*, *Asia* and a guest Associate Editor for *Circulation*, as well as a member of the editorial board for *Circulation Research* and *Journal of Biological Chemistry*. Dr. Wang was an Established Investigator, Thomas Smith Memorial Lecturer as well as Basic Research Prize recipient of American Heart Association. Dr. Wang also received 2021 Excellence in Educational Innovation Award from UCLA College of Life Science. Dr. Wang holds 4 patents including three licensed and is a scientific co-founder of a biotech company.
