

Dr. Junichi Sadoshima is an expert of basic mechanisms of cardiac failure, recognized worldwide. Dr. Sadoshima serves as Professor and Chair of the Department of Cell Biology and Molecular Medicine at Rutgers New Jersey Medical School. Dr. Sadoshima has published >400 articles. His research programs are supported for over 3 decades by awards from the NIH. He served as the North American coordinator of the Leducq Transatlantic Network. Dr. Sadoshima serves on the Editorial Board of 14 journals, including Circulation Research, JMCC, and JCI, and the Cardiovascular Section Editor for Autophagy. Dr. Sadoshima has received Katz Basic Science Research Prize (AHA, 1995), Cardiovascular Research Prize (AHA, 2001), Janice Pfeffer Distinguished Lecture Award (ISHR, 2010); Thomas Smith Memorial Lecture Award (AHA, 2014); BCVS Distinguished Investigator Award (AHA, 2017); Merit Award (AHA, 2020). He is a member of the American Society for Clinical Investigation (ASCI) and a fellow of AHA and ISHR.
