

Mario Delmar obtained his MD from the Metropolitan University (1980) and his PhD from the National Polytechnic Institute, both in Mexico (1986). In 1988 he joined the Faculty at SUNY-Syracuse, reaching Professor in 1998. In 2008 he joined University of Michigan as the Frank N Wilson Professor of Cardiology. In 2010 he moved to New York University and in 2015 was named the Patricia and Robert Martinsen Professor of Cardiology. Dr. Delmar has published 180 papers and his research has been supported by NIH, without interruption, since 1988. He has served multiple NIH study sections, most recently as member of ESTA (2017-2021) and Chair of MPPB (2021-2023), and has received several distinctions including the 2020 Distinguished Scientist Award from the Heart Rhythm Society, and an R35 Outstanding Investigator Award from NIH (2022). His research is on sudden cardiac arrest in the young, with focus on arrhythmogenic right ventricular cardiomyopathy (ARVC).
