Richard N. Kitsis, M.D., is Professor of Medicine (Cardiology) and Professor of Cell Biology, the Dr. Gerald and Myra Dorros Chair in Cardiovascular Disease, and Director, Wilf Family Cardiovascular Research Institute at Albert Einstein College of Medicine in New York City. His laboratory studies fundamental mechanisms of cell death and mitochondrial biology and roles of cell death in human disease, in particular myocardial infarction. Dr. Kitsis has received the ISHR President's Award and the Schottenstein Prize in Cardiovascular Sciences.
