

Zoltan V. Varga, MD., PhD

Zoltan V Varga is an Associate Professor and Vice Director of the Department of Pharmacology and Pharmacotherapy at Semmelweis University, Budapest, Hungary. He graduated in 2009 (M.D.), received his Ph.D degree in 2013 and had postdoctoral training at the NIH in Bethesda, MD, USA from 2015-2018. Since 2018 he is the group leader of the Cardiometabolic Immunology Research Group of the Hungarian Center of Excellence in Molecular Medicine at the Semmelweis University and since 2021 the Momentum Cardio-oncology and Cardioimmunology Research Group of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences. His research covers interdisciplinary areas of molecular cardiology, metabolic syndrome, and cardiovascular immunology and pharmacology. His group in recent years focuses on understanding the spectrum of cardiotoxicity of immune checkpoint inhibitors, as well as the mechanisms behind HFpEF and HFrEF, placing special emphasis on studying the role of inflammatory interorgan interactions in these disease states.
